This graph shows the average custodial sentence length given to adult for offenders convicted of assault by penetration. In 2018 the longest average sentence length for this offence was given to offenders, a length of 6 years. In contrast, 2011 saw the shortest average sentence length of 3 years and 6 months. The Sentencing Council's Definitive Guideline for sexual offences came into force in April 2014. The introduction of this guideline may have contributed to the increase in average length of custodial sentence from 4 years in years in the pre-definitive guideline period to between 5 and 6 years on average post-definitive guideline period, however, further research would be required to confirm this. Regardless, the general trend is of an increase in sentence lengths from 2010 to 2014, until a general plateau between 2015-2020 of around 5 years and 5 months on average.
